DYSLEXIA TALK by RON YOSHIMOTO

Title: Dyslexia and the Orton-Gillingham Approach: A Perfect Match

Dyslexia is a language-based learning disability. Individuals with dyslexia have trouble with reading, writing, spelling and/or math although they have the ability and have had opportunities to learn. Dyslexia is a life-long condition. However, its impact can change at different stages in a person's life. Individuals with dyslexia can learn; they just learn in a different way.

The presenter will discuss dyslexia and explain the need for educational therapy. He will describe one of the major interventions - the Orton-Gillingham (OG) Approach and provide simulation exercises for the audience. There will be demonstrations of OG strategies to assist a child in reading, spelling, handwriting, vocabulary and math. This will be an interactive and insightful session with demonstrations of multi-sensory activities.
